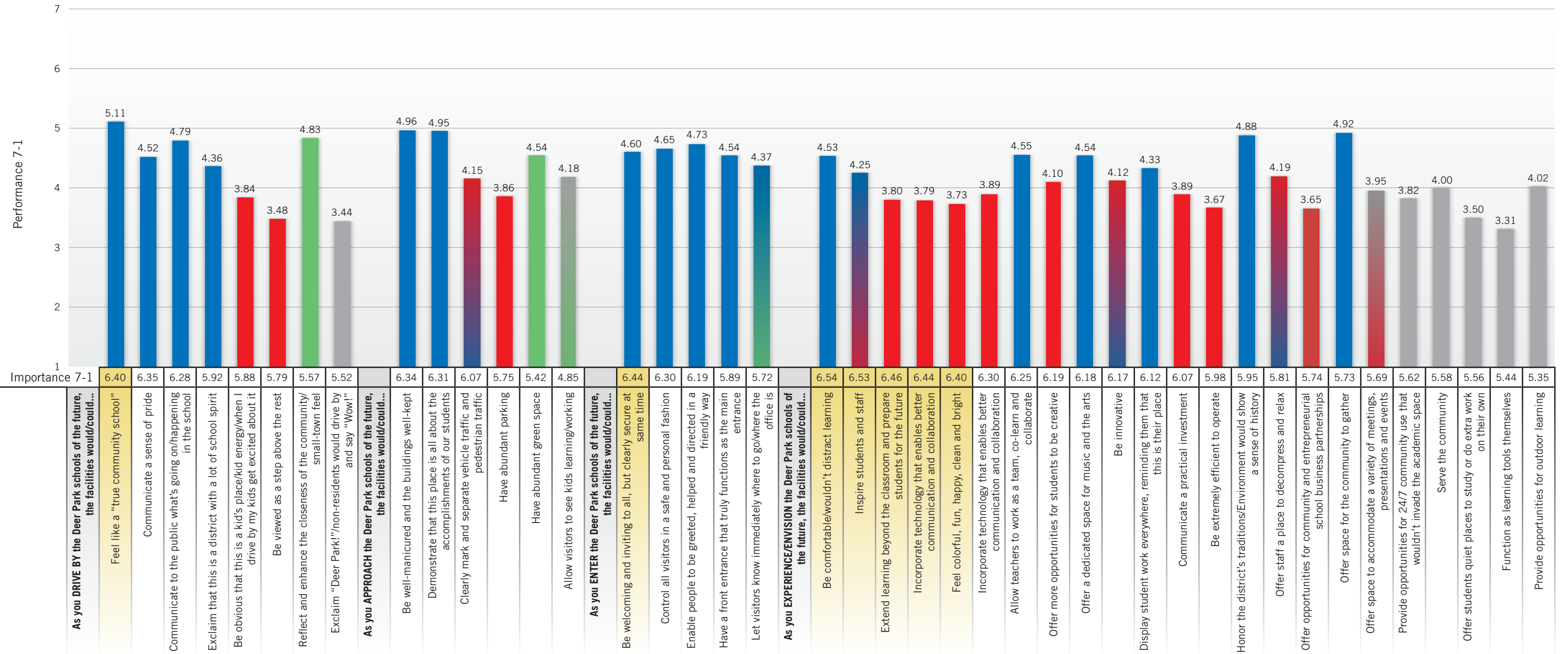

CONTINUE

Values/issues of relatively higher importance and relatively higher performance. The resources and energy related to these values/issues should be supported.

IMPROVE

Values/issues of relatively higher importance and relatively lower performance. The resources and energy related to these values/issues should be upgraded.

REALLOCATE

Values/issues of relatively lower importance and relatively higher performance. The resources and energy related to these values/issues should be shifted.

MONITOR

Values/issues of relatively lower importance and relatively lower performance. The resources and energy related to these values/issues should be tracked.

Importance Midpoint: 5.695
Performance Midpoint: 4.21

Importance Question: How important are these Values to you?

Performance Question: How well do you believe the current Deer Park facilities perform on these Values?

Sample Size: Total 267 respondents. Individuals identified themselves as: Parents, Teachers, Community-at-Large, Support Staff, Graduates, Students, Administrators, Business Persons, Board Member.

Margin of Error: 5.42% (The overall estimated margin of sampling error is +/- 5.42%, based on a confidence level of 95%, although it varies for each individual question.)
